

Cookie policy

Our website uses cookies to distinguish you from other users of our website. This helps us to provide you with a good experience when you browse our website and also allows us to improve our site. A cookie is a small file of letters and numbers that we store on your browser or the hard drive of your computer if you agree. By visiting or using our website with your browser set to allow cookies, you are consenting to our use of cookies for the purposes set out below.

To make full use of our website and to benefit from certain personalised features your computer, tablet or mobile phone will need to be set up to accept cookies. Some of our website's features may not work when cookies are blocked. If you would like to learn more about cookies generally then a good source of information is: www.allaboutcookies.org

Categories

The list below sets out some of the different categories of cookies that exist:

Strictly necessary cookies. Strictly necessary cookies ensure that a website is able to function properly, provide core services and features that help keep a website secure and that help detect fraud or crime. A website doesn't have to ask for consent to store these cookies on a user's browser.

Analytical or performance cookies. These allow websites to recognise and count the number of visitors and to see how visitors move around a website when they are using it. This helps websites to improve the way their website works, for example, by ensuring that users are finding what they are looking for easily.

Functionality cookies. These are used to recognise users when they return to a website. This enables websites to personalise content for the user, greet the user by name and remember the user's preferences (for example, the user's choice of language or region).

Targeting cookies. These cookies record user's visits to a website, the pages users have visited and the links they have followed. Websites will use this information to make their website and the advertising displayed on it more relevant to the user's interests.

Duration

In terms of duration, there are two types of cookie:

Session cookies aka transient cookies: These cookies are erased when site visitors close their browsers and are not used to collect information from their computers. They typically store information in the form of a session identification that does not personally identify the user.

Persistent cookies aka permanent or stored cookies: These cookies are stored on a site visitor's hard drive until they expire (at a set expiration date) or until they are deleted. These cookies are used to collect identifying information about the user, such as web surfing behaviour or user preferences for a specific site.
